Three-needle flatbed chainstitch styles for



lapseaming jeans risers and seats

General description: Flatbed, three needle, six thread 401 stitch machine with high throw. For double lap seaming operations on overalls, jeans, jackets and similar garments of medium to heavy weight materials.

Standard Features: rear, upper belt-driven roller puller, CC2 pneumatic Air-Klipp® chain cutter, PA1 pneumatic lift for the presser foot and puller, needle cooler, and 1/8" (3.2mm) capacity spring-loaded double lap seam folder. *All styles are available without CC2 or PA1 work aid attachments.*

Stitch length range: 7-10 SPI (2.5-3.6mm), set at 8 SPI (3.2mm). **Needle:** 128GAS140/054.

Needle gauges: 3.2 or 3.6mm (1/8" or 9/64") - 6.4 or 7.2mm (1/4" or 9/32") with center needle removed.

FS315L63-3H $\frac{32}{36}$ /CC2/PA1	Differential feed machine with .070 (1.8mm) step sewing parts.
FS316L61-3H $\frac{32}{36}$ /CC2/PA1	Plain feed machine with flat (no step) sewing parts.
FS316L62-3H $\frac{32}{36}$ /CC2/PA1	Plain feed machine with .040 (1mm) step sewing parts.
FS316L63-3H $\frac{32}{36}$ /CC2/PA1	Plain feed machine with .070 (1.8mm) step sewing parts.
FS316L63-3H 48 /PA1	Same as FS316L63-3H36, except 4.8mm needle gauge, and no chain cutter.



Benefits for increased production/reduced labor on these flatbed felling machines include

- Differential feed (FS315) makes matching plies easy
- A rear, upper belt-driven roller puller improves feeding and relieves operator effort
- Air-Klipp® chain cutter for clean appearance at beginning and end of seam
- Pneumatically assisted lift for the presser foot and roller
- Needle cooler reduces thread breakage
